



INDIANA REDISTRICTING WHAT THE NEW MAP DOES

KEY CHANGES

- All 9 districts drawn to favor one party
- **IN-1 (Northwest Indiana)** and **IN-7 (Indianapolis)** redrawn away from usual voting patterns
- No districts remain competitive

COMMUNITY IMPACT

- **Minority voters diluted** in IN-1 & IN-7
- **Urban and rural areas lumped together**, despite different local needs
- Districts cross **Eastern & Central** time zones, complicating representation
- Boundaries don't reflect Indiana's demographic diversity

PROCESS FACTS

- **Mid-decade redraw** not required by census or law
- Map released **hours before** hearing
- Hearings held after **map was drawn**
- Legal challenges go **directly to Indiana Supreme Court**, bypassing lower courts

WHAT RESIDENTS EXPECT

- A map that reflects **real communities**
- **Transparency** in boundary decisions
- **Public participation** before a map is finalized
