KEY CHANGES

- All 9 districts drawn to favor one party
- IN-1 (Northwest Indiana) and IN-7 (Indianapolis) redrawn away from usual voting patterns
- · No districts remain competitive

COMMUNITY IMPACT

- Minority voters diluted in IN-1 & IN-7
- **Urban and rural areas lumped together**, despite different local needs
- Districts cross Eastern & Central time zones, complicating representation
- Boundaries don't reflect Indiana's demographic diversity

PROCESS FACTS

- Mid-decade redraw not required by census or law
- Map released hours before hearing
- Hearings held after map was drawn
- Legal challenges go directly to Indiana Supreme Court, bypassing lower courts

WHAT RESIDENTS EXPECT

- A map that reflects real communities
- Transparency in boundary decisions
- Public participation before a map is finalized
